Program will accept MATH 2283, 2228 or PSYC 2101, but BIOS 1500 is preferred. BIOS 1500 is not typically offered in the summer sessions and must be completed before entry into program.

³HIMA 3000 and HSMA 3115 NOT needed for AHC students. 6 hours of extra electives required.
