



## Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS) to BFA Theatre Arts

The Bachelor of Fine Arts in Theatre Arts requires a minimum of 120 semester hours. ECU requires a minimum 2.0 overall GPA and a minimum 2.0 major GPA for graduation. Theatre arts majors must attain a minimum grade of C- (1.7) in all required theatre courses.

The BFA in Theatre Arts offers concentrations in the following areas: Design and Production, Musical Theatre, Professional Actor Training, Stage Management, and Theatre for Youth. Admission to the Musical Theatre, Professional Actor Training, and Theatre for Youth concentrations are by adjudication.
