Minimum S.H. Required for Degree 124

The Bachelor of Arts in English requires a minimum of 124 semester hours. ECU requires a minimum 2.0 overall GPA and a minimum 2.0 major GPA for graduation. English Majors must complete a senior writing portfolio as a requirement for graduation.

¹Students enrolling at ECU must fulfill the writing across the curriculum requirement prior to graduation. To do so, each student must complete a minimum of 12 semester hours of writing intensive (WI) courses, including ENGL 1100 and ENGL 2201; at least 3 semester hours of WI courses in the major; and any other 3 semester hours WI course of the student's choice.

²Students enrolling at ECU are required to complete two three-hour diversity courses: one course with a domestic diversity (DD) focus and one with a global diversity (GD) focus. Courses that transfer to ECU as equivalent to an ECU course that is approved for diversity credit receive diversity credit. Transfer courses that are not equivalent to existing ECU diversity courses may be approved for diversity credit by the General Education and Instructional Effectiveness Committee. ⁴Choose 6 s.h. of ENGL, FILM, or LING electives 4000 or above, excluding ENGL 4510, 4520, 4550, 4555, 4890, and 4891.
