Students are admitted into the major during the fall semester only. Online applications are accepted February 15 - August 1. Students must complete SOCW 1010 and 2010 with a minimum C in each course and an average 2.5 GPA to be accepted into the major. Majors must pass all required social work courses with a minimum grade of C (2.0).

*Recommended that transfer students also complete ENGL 2100 (ENG 243), ENGL 2200 (ENG 233), LAT 142 (CLAS 2230), or POLS 2010 (POL 210) to fulfill ECU Writing Intensive (WI) requirement.

Course availability, prior credit, course prerequisites, major requirements, and student needs must be considered in developing the individual academic pathway.
