Minimum S.H. Required for Degree 120

The Bachelor of Arts in Foreign Language and Literatures requires a minimum of 120 semester hours. ECU requires a minimum 2.0 overall GPA and a minimum 2.0 major GPA for graduation. The French, German, Global, and Hispanic studies concentrations require a minor and general electives to complete requirements for graduation. In the second semester of the junior year all foreign language and literatures majors, with the exception of global studies, must pass an oral qualifying examination.

¹Students enrolling at ECU must fulfill the writing across the curriculum requirement prior to graduation. To do so, each student must complete a minimum of 12 semester hours of writing intensive (WI) courses, including ENGL 1100 and ENGL 2201; at least 3 semester hours of WI courses in the major; and any other 3 semester hours WI course of the student's choice.

²Students enrolling at ECU are required to complete two three-hour diversity courses: one course with a domestic diversity (DD) focus and one with a global diversity (GD) focus. Courses that transfer to ECU as equivalent to an ECU course that is approved for diversity credit receive diversity credit. Transfer courses that are not equivalent to existing ECU diversity courses may be approved for diversity credit by the General Education and Instructional Effectiveness Committee. ³Choose 15-18 s.h. of SPAN electives above 2999 (15 s.h. of electives for student who take SPAN 3001 and SPAN 3002; 18 s.h. of electives for students who taken SPAN 3001 and SPAN 3003): A minimum of 6 s.h. from - SPAN 4010, 4020, 4030, 4555, 4556, 4557, 4558, 4560, 4561, 4562, 4563; A minimum of 3 s.h. from - SPAN 3325, 3335, 4320, 4330. The remaining electives can be any SPAN course above 2999.

Course availability, prior credit, course prerequisites, major requirements, and student needs must be considered in developing an individual academic pathway.
