



## Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS) to BFA Art

Due to the individual complexities of this program, interested transfer students should contact the ECU School of Art and Design directly and as early as possible in their studies. For more information, students should contact: [artadvising@ecu.edu](mailto:artadvising@ecu.edu).

The Bachelor of Fine Arts in Art requires a minimum of 120 semester hours. ECU requires a minimum 2.0 overall GPA and a minimum 2.0 major GPA for graduation. Art students must complete an approved senior art show as a requirement for graduation.

Portfolio review is required for acceptance into an Art concentration. Concentrations are offered in animation and interactive design, ceramics, film and video production, graphic design, illustration, metal design, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture, and textile design. Entrance is competitive and space may be limited. Students not accepted into their preferred area of concentration should be prepared to seek alternative areas of concentration and/or degree programs. Students should speak with faculty in the desired concentration to receive detailed instructions regarding the portfolio review process and requirements.
