



Associate in Arts (AA) and/or Associate in Science (AS) to BM Music

The sequence below is contingent on the student completing the AA/AS degree from a college in the North Carolina Community College System.

Due to the individual complexities of this program, interested transfer students should contact the ECU School of Music directly and as early as possible in their studies. For more information, students should contact Judy Barber, Assistant Director for Student Services at barberju@ecu.edu.

The Bachelor of Music requires a minimum of 128 semester hours. ECU requires a minimum 2.0 overall GPA and a minimum 2.0 major GPA for graduation. The Bachelor of Music degree has three concentrations: Music Therapy, Music Performance, and Music Theory/Composition.

Prospective music majors and minors must be admitted both to the university and to the School of Music. Admission to the university does not guarantee admission to the School of Music. Admission to the School of Music is determined through a competitive audition process consisting of an acceptable personal or recorded performance and an evaluation of theory and aural skills. A satisfactory audition is required of all entering freshmen, transfer students, and students being readmitted. Application to the School of Music is made by completing a Music Application which requires a statement of purpose and two letters of recommendation.
