



Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS) to BFA Theatre Arts, Musical Theatre Concentration

The sequence below is contingent on the student completing the AA or AS degree from a college in the North Carolina Community College System.

The Bachelor of Fine Arts in Theatre Arts requires a minimum of 120 semester hours. ECU requires a minimum 2.0 overall GPA and a minimum 2.0 major GPA for graduation. Theatre arts majors must attain a minimum grade of C in all required theatre courses.
