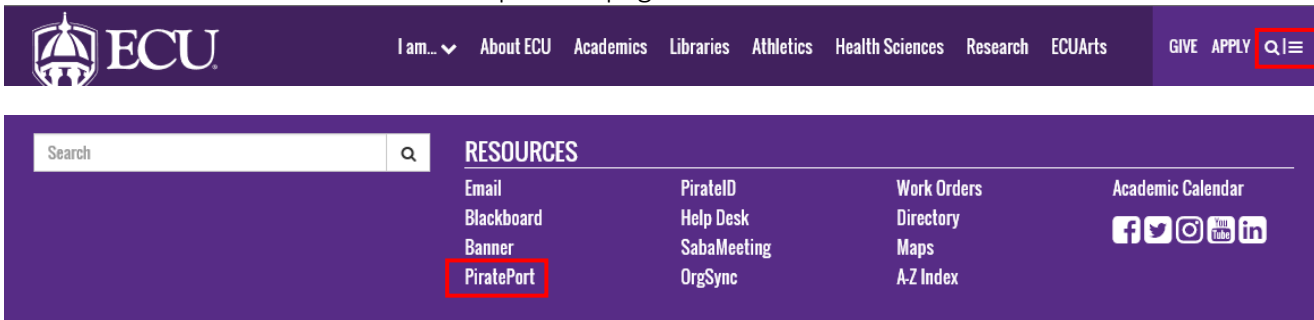
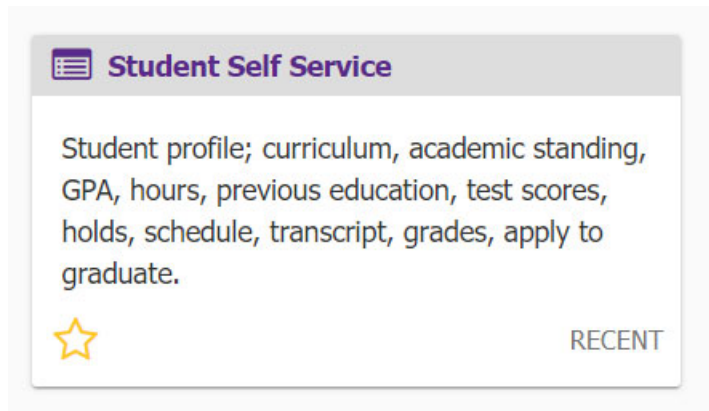



How to View Course Instructional Method for Registered Courses

11. Explanation of instructional methods:

- a. Face to face – course will meet on campus for course instruction.
- b. Hybrid Primarily Face to Face – course will meet primarily on campus and include an online component for instruction.
- c. Hybrid Primarily Online – course will be conducted primarily through online instruction but will have some on campus course instruction.
- d. Internet or World Wide Web – course will be conducted through online instruction. May include synchronous instruction in which the course will meet online during specific days and times.
- e. Face to Face Remote Site – specialty courses that may conduct instruction at a remote site off campus.
- f. Interactive Real Time Video – specialty courses where instruction is conducted through two-way video.
