Minimum Credit Hours Required for Graduation:

The Bachelor of Arts in Mathematics requires a minimum of 120 semester hours. ECU requires a minimum 2.0 overall GPA and a minimum 2.0 major GPA for graduation. Credit toward a mathematics major will not be given in any MATH course with a grade less than C- (1.7).
