Minimum Credit Hours Required for Graduation:

The Bachelor of Fine Arts in Theatre Arts Education requires a minimum of 120 semester hours. ECU requires a minimum 2.0 overall GPA and a minimum 2.0 major GPA for graduation. Students interested in this program should contacte the department chairperson prior to enrollment. Students are admitted to the program by jury audition or portfolio, writing sample, and interview.
