Due to the sequential nature of the Dance curriculum, students are required to complete 4 years of coursework at ECU to complete the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree.

- Completing course work at the community college will lighten a student's course load at ECU, allowing some students to double major or minor if they choose to.
- If you complete course work at the community college the following courses will be helpful, as they will fulfill specific general education course requirements for the Dance BFA.
