

Baccalaureate Degree Plan

NCCCS Associate in Arts **or** Associate in Science transfer to
East Carolina University, **BS Interior Design**

The interior design major is accredited by the <u>Council for Interior Design Accreditation</u> (CIDA) and the National Association of Schools of Art and Design (NASAD).

Students can declare the interior design major

- upon completion of <u>IDSN 1081</u>, <u>IDSN 1180</u>, <u>IDSN 1181</u>, <u>IDSN 1200</u>, and <u>IDSN 1500</u>, with a C (2.0) or higher;
- a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5;
- and an acceptable level of proficiency in studio work as shown in the portfolio review.

As a transfer student, it is important to contact an ECU Academic Advisor, hhpadvising@ecu.edu, as soon as possible.

An example of how to plan your first 2 years of the traditional 4 years of study is included at the end of this document. However, depending on when you transfer and how many recommended courses you take at the community college, it may take longer than 4 years to complete any degree at ECU.

- Other courses to complete an AA or AS are student's choice; no other current department recommendations. Other equivalent courses may be listed in the degree requirements.
- Completion of an approved NCCCS AA or AS waives the General Education requirement. For more information about the waiver, click here.

- You do not have to complete all NCCCS equivalents or recommended courses before transferring. However, taking minimal recommendations may prolong your time to degree at ECU.

Degree Requirements

40 semester hours credit required; completion of an approved AA or AS waives this requirement, with the exception of Health Promotion and Health-Related Physical Activity.

*DES courses are not approved CAA transfer courses; students are not expected to complete these before entering ECU. However, if you were to complete these courses at a community college they would transfer toward your degree at ECU.
