Associate in Applied Science degrees through the North Carolina Community College system are not necessarily designed to transfer to 4-year institutions. However, ECU wants to see you complete your bachelor's degree regardless of the associate degree you complete. Therefore, we have created AAS Transfer Plans for popular NCCCS AAS degrees.
